The responses were varied and provided useful feedback. We also linked with our council for voluntary services (CVS), which proved helpful in identifying many other groups, including those representing the disadvantaged within our communities.

In addition, we supported our local college in running a careers showcase as we are keen to enrol more members from the younger age group and this was a perfect opportunity to engage. Hopefully this will eventually lead to a youth governor on the council of governors.

We have also expanded our successful Meet Your Governor events, where we talk to patients, carers, visitors, and staff, from our local communities.

We have developed relationships with governors from other organisations within our integrated care system, with the goal of holding joint Meet Your Governor events to better understand all our communities and how governors can support them in ensuring all services provided across our health system are responsive to community needs.
